Subject: Policy of Not Accepting Gifts or Benefits (No Gift Policy) 2026

The National Innovation Agency (Public Organization), or NIA, is committed to managing its operations with transparency under the principles of Good Governance and to recognizing the importance of anti-corruption. To create social value, responsibility, and equality among all stakeholders, NIA promotes the values of integrity, cost-effectiveness, and the application of a zero-tolerance approach to corruption, in alignment with the National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct.

NIA officers and staff shall neither accept nor give gifts, benefits, or any other advantages arising from the performance of their duties, both before and after such performance, in order to prevent corruption and misconduct. NIA also stands firmly against all forms of corruption to strengthen a culture of integrity and transparency. In cases of necessity where gifts or benefits must be given or received in accordance with ethical or traditional practices, such actions must strictly comply with the Notification of the N.C.C. Commission Concerning the Acceptance of Property or Any Other Benefit on an Ethical Basis by State Officials, B.E. 2563.

Furthermore, all NIA officers and staff are responsible for communicating and publicizing this policy to external parties and stakeholders to ensure full awareness and compliance.

This policy is hereby announced and shall be strictly adhered to by all concerned.
